Scholarship Submission Guidelines - Submissions will be accepted from members and non-members of WFCU. Submissions must be from youth enrolled in an educational institution in Grades JK to 12, as of September 2013. By accepting the Scholarship, all recipients give consent to have their photo taken and used along with their name in any promotional marketing material featuring WFCU. All Scholarships will be entrusted to WFCU and will accumulate interest to which time the recipient is enrolled in a university or college, business school or trade school. The funds will be disbursed to the learning institution of the recipient's choosing after proof of enrollment is submitted to WFCU. Funds will not be released directly to the recipient. Scholarships cannot be used for any other purpose than post-secondary education. Scholarships are non-transferable. Submission close date is Friday, April 18, 2014. No entries will be accepted after this date. Scholarships must be redeemed by age 21. WFCU reserves the right to alter or cancel the request for submissions without notification.
